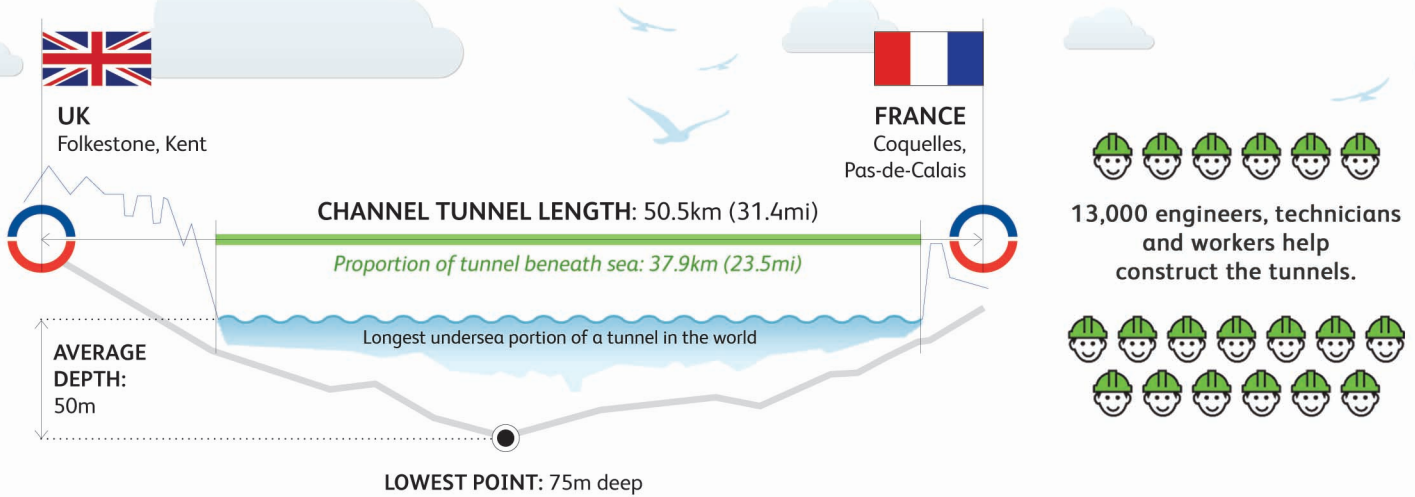

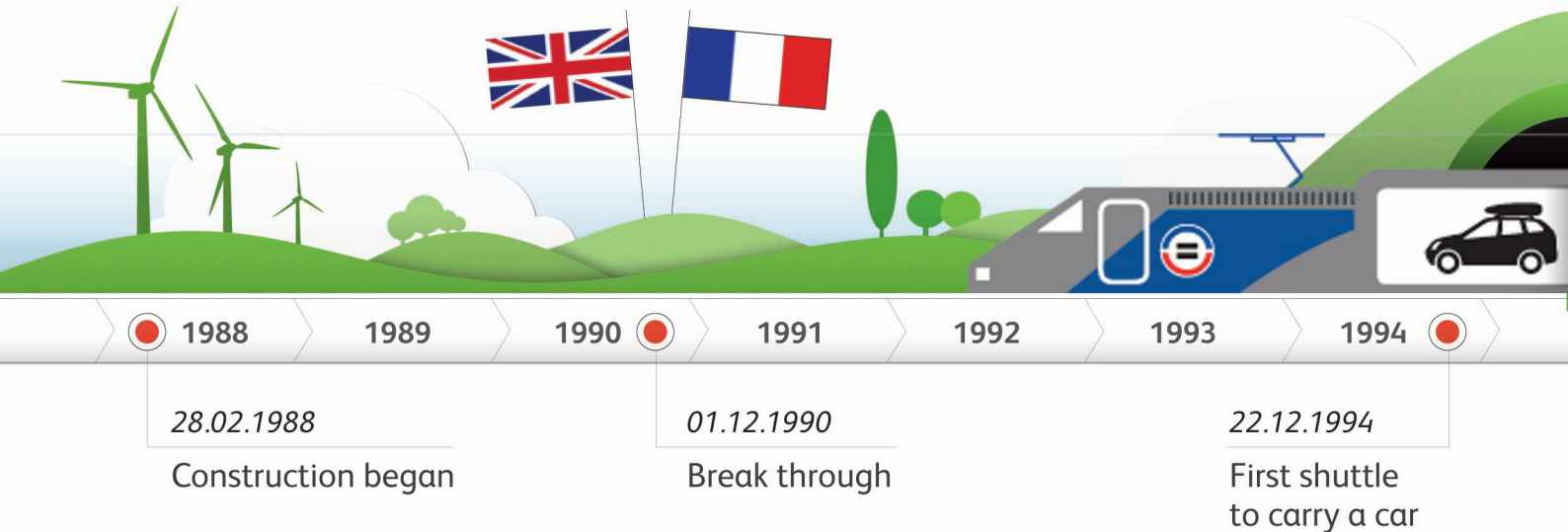

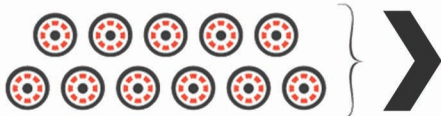

HOW THE TUNNEL WAS BUILT

11 tunnel boring machines were used in the excavation, many of them built specially for the project.

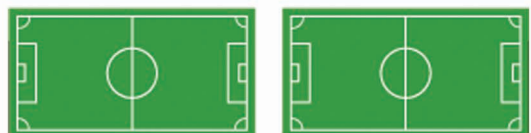


Weight of each machine is 1,100 tonnes together they weigh more than the Eiffel Tower



WEMBLEY

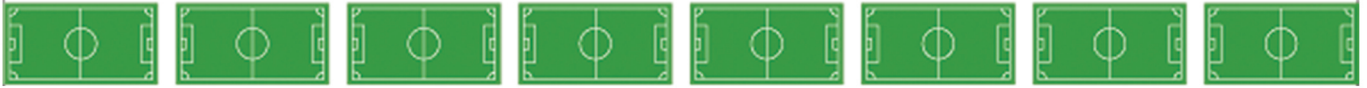
The spoil removed from the tunnel could fill Wembley Stadium 13 times



11 tunnel boring machines as long as two football pitches dug 250ft per day.

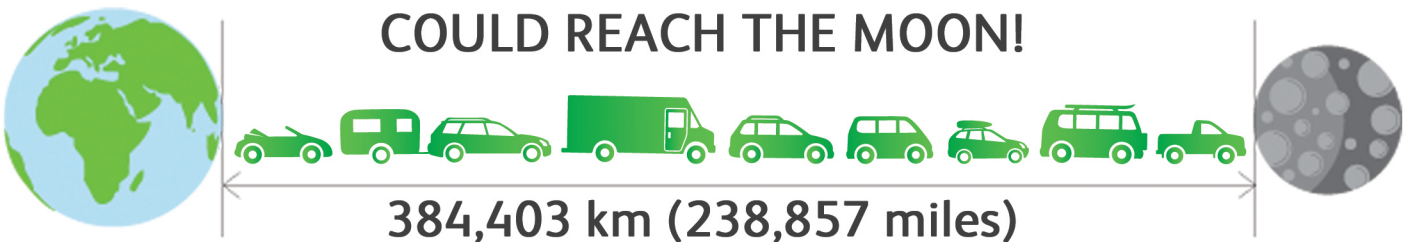
A Eurotunnel shuttle is 755 metres long

ROUGHLY THE SAME AS EIGHT FOOTBALL PITCHES



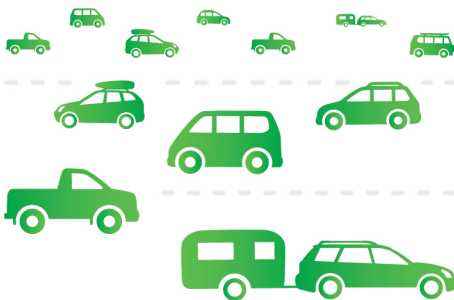
Parked nose to tail, the vehicles that have travelled with Eurotunnel Le Shuttle
